It takes only three simple steps to start earning rewards for the time spent with your favorite Regular Registry or Solid Paint-Bred horse. And all the forms you need are easily accessible at apha.com/rideamerica or by contacting APHA.

1. Sign up

Joining Ride America is a snap! Simply fill out the enrollment application and send it in, along with a one-time \$25 fee (members rate).

Once this is done, you and your Paint Horse are enrolled, and will continue to be enrolled in the program as long as your APHA or AjPHA membership remains current.

2. Submit time logs

APHA offers two ways to keep track of your hours. Choose the one that works best for you:

- Log your time on-line at aphaonline.com; or
- Mail in your official log forms, which can be downloaded from the Web site or requested from APHA.

3. Earn awards

Logging hours is important because APHA rewards Ride America participants at several milestones, from 100 hours up to 10,000 hours. Your Paint Horse builds a permanent APHA performance record and you could earn credit toward great prizes, including tack, clothing, trail gear,  belt buckles, discounts on official APHA trail rides and much more!
