



Act now to enroll your solid Paint-Bred horse in the Breeders Trust program

For a limited time, the American Paint Horse Association is giving owners a chance to enroll their solid Paint-Bred horses in the popular Breeders Trust program, no matter the horse's age or number of points earned.

The Breeders Trust was created by APHA in 1994 to help offset the cost of showing and racing Paint Horses and to make them more marketable. The program provides added incentives for Paint enthusiasts who exhibit their horses in the show ring and on the racetrack. Stallion owners pay into the Trust annually so that stallion's offspring are eligible to take part in the program. Once a foal is enrolled in the program, it can earn a check every year that it earns points.

The Breeders Trust incentive fund payments are based on a point value system, with each point earned at an APHA-approved event in the Open and Amateur divisions being worth a specific amount of money. Yearly dividends are paid to subscribed stallion owners, foal nominators and recorded owners of horses enrolled in the program.

Typically, horses must be enrolled before the end of their 2-year-old year and before earning any points. However, these stipulations are being waived through December 31, 2006, for solid Paint-Breds.

This waiver applies to any solid Paint-Bred horse that has at least one Paint parent and whose sire was subscribed for the breeding year that the foal was conceived.

It is important to take advantage of this special opportunity soon, because this late enrollment program is available for only one year (January 1 to December 31, 2006).

Weanlings, yearlings and 2-year-olds (even those that have earned points) can enter at the regular fees, and aged horses can enroll at the following rates:

3-year-old	\$1,200
4-year-old	\$1,600
5-year-old and older	\$2,000

Points earned beginning January 1, 2007, will be used to calculate Breeders Trust dividend payouts of horses that enroll in the Breeders Trust through the limited-time waiver. Yearly dividends from that point forward will be handled like normal enrollments.
