

## **2012 Rule Changes/Clarifications**

(Refer to the 2012 APHA Rules and Regulations to read the rule in its entirety.)

- **SC-185.F. Exhibiting Multiple Horses**

An exhibitor may exhibit a maximum of five horses, with no maximum restriction on the number of Junior or Senior horses in individual working events. (see listing of classes in rule book) Rule SC-185.E.

  1. In Yearling Longe Line and Yearling In-Hand Trail, an exhibitor may show a maximum of two horses.
  
- **AM-075.A.2. Show Approval Rules**

A show offering Amateur classes must offer a minimum of three (3) Amateur Solid Paint-Bred halter classes (stallions, mares and geldings) and a minimum of three (3) Amateur Solid Paint-Bred performance classes. Exception: State Fairs and Livestock shows.
  
- **AM-080.B Combining and Splitting Age Groups**

Show management may combine or split age groups of amateur exhibitors as justified by entries if there is unanimous consent of all involved exhibitors, however, if one division is not a two (2)-point earning class, then show management may combine age groups without unanimous consent of all exhibitors. YP-075.B. changes also.
  
- **YP-110.B. Youth Walk-Trot Age**

This division is for Youth five (5) to ten (10) years of age.
