**5% STALLION AWARD**

1) The owner of the stallion who sires the Futurity winner will receive a Breeders Award of 5% of the total purse.

**NOMINATION FEE:**  
\$100 on or before November 15, 2004

**SUSTAINING PAYMENTS:**  
\$150 on or before January 15, 2005  
\$200 on or before April 15, 2005  
\$200 on or before June 15, 2005

**ENTRY FEE:**  
\$100 due at time of entry for trials

**TOTAL: \$750**

**LATE NOMINATIONS:**

1) \$100 by January 15, 2005 plus all back payments (total \$350)

2) \$500 by April 15, 2005 plus all back payments (total \$950).

3) \$5000 at time of entry for trials plus all back payments (total \$5,750).

**Ten horse gates will be used for the Trials and Futurity.**

**Purse to be divided:** 50% to winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 6% to fourth, 4% to fifth, 3% to sixth, 2.5% to seventh, 2% to eighth, 1.5% to ninth, 1% to tenth.  
Turf Paradise to contribute purse for consolation.

# 2005 AQRA FUTURITY

## RULES AND REGULATIONS

The undersigned represents that he/she and all persons for whom he/she are acting have read and are familiar with the Rules of Racing and Regulations of the Arizona Racing Commission and the race meeting conditions and agrees to be bound by and comply with the acts and decisions of the Arizona Racing Commission and the race track officials and that all animals shall be subject to the same and to the acts and decisions of the race officials and agrees to be bound by the following terms and conditions. All stable reservations and entries in stakes and all other races are received and accepted subject to all conditions, rules and regulations of the Arizona Racing Commission and the Race Track Permittee.

**ELIGIBILITY AND NOMINATION:** This race is open to foals of 2003 which are registered with the American Quarter Horse Association, and sired by eligible stallions named on the front of this nomination blank. Owners of nominated entries must be members of the Arizona Quarter Racing Association (AQRA).

**PURSE:** Stallion nominating fees, less 10%, plus the nomination fees, sustaining fees, and late penalties will be distributed as described on the front of this form.

**ELIMINATIONS:** Each trial shall consist of not more than ten (10) horses. The trials shall be raced under the same conditions as the finals. No more than ten (10) horses shall be selected from the trials to participate in the finals. If less than 13 horses are entered for the trials a 12 horse gate will be used for the final with no trials. The horses shall be selected on a time basis. Times of horses in separate trials will be determined only to the limit of the electronic timer; one one-hundredth of a second. If two horses in the same trial heat receive the same time, they will qualify according to official order of finish. No adjustments will be made in the recorded time of the trials for head wind, tail wind, off track, etc. Should a mechanical failure occur with the electronic timer on any time trials, finalists will then be selected by stop watches. If in the opinion of the Stewards, a track condition change occurs during the trials such as rain or a fast drying track, the finalists will then be selected in order of finish. If for any reason a tie exists, the horses involved shall draw lots to determine which shall participate in the finals. Should a horse be disqualified, he will be given the time of the horse he is immediately placed behind plus 1/100 of one second. If the gates on the starting gate fail to open during the running of the trials and money on the horse is refunded to the public, such horse shall be declared a non-starter and all nominating, sustaining, and entry fees shall be refunded to the owner of said horse. During the running of the finals and/or consolation such horse shall be declared a non-starter and shall be classified as a scratched horse and shall be paid last purse money in said race. The decision of the Stewards is all matters shall be final and the entries are accepted only on the condition that those persons nominating and/or starting a horse in the trials and/or finals and/or consolation agree to abide by their decisions. If any part of an entry is disqualified it may disqualify all of the entry. All trials will be run a minimum of five days preceding the finals/consolation. All rules or new rules adopted by the Arizona Racing Commission supersede any condition of this race. Entries will be split if possible. The race track reserves the right to hold trials on this race on a non-race day or at their discretion. There will be no also-eligible lists in the trials or finals of the AQRA Futurity. If scratches occur, then the race will run with those remaining. If two or more horses scratch out of the same race of the finals or consolation, then the last place purse monies in the race shall be added together and divided equally between owners of such horses.

**OTHER:** The race track permittee and the AQRA reserve the right to cancel this race without liability except for the return of stallion nomination fees, sustaining and entrance fees, paid to the owners of the eligible horses at the time of cancellation, and to the owners at the time of forfeit on horses which have not been kept eligible, and/or after any race condition for any reason which they deem good and sufficient, and also reserves the right to have its track veterinarian mouth or inspect any nominee for age any time after arrival of the nominee at the race track.

The AQRA will not be liable or responsible for any injury or loss suffered in any manner through negligence or cause, by condition of premises, or otherwise, by or to the horse or horses or equipment of the undersigned while on the premises (including stalls, stables, or other property) granted or leased by the track management or AQRA or elsewhere off the premises or while being transported in any manner on or off the premises. The undersigned will hold the AQRA harmless, against any cost, attorney's fees, loss or damage suffered by the undersigned or by other person or persons, by reason of any horse of the undersigned while on the premises.

**ANY OWNER MAY NOMINATE AS MANY DIFFERENT ENTRIES AS DESIRED. IF ONE OR MORE ARE WITHDRAWN BEFORE THE RACE, BE SURE TO SPECIFY WHICH ONES ARE SO WITHDRAWN WHEN MAKING PAYMENTS. PLEASE NOTIFY THE TURF PARADISE HORSEMEN'S BOOKKEEPER IMMEDIATELY OF ANY SALE OF NOMINEE OR CHANGE OF ADDRESS OF OWNER.**
