ELIGIBILITY: ONLY A.Q.H.A. AND APHA REGISTERED FOALS Sired BY A STALLION STANDING IN ARIZONA THE 2002 BREEDING SEASON ELIGIBLE. NO SEX ALLOWANCE.

MUST BE A CURRENT MEMBER OF THE A.Q.R.A. IF YOU HAVE NOT PAID YOUR MEMBERSHIP IN 2004, PLEASE ADD \$35.00 FOR A SINGLE MEMBERSHIP OR \$50.00 FOR A HUSBAND/WIFE OR PARTNERSHIP.

All nominations and sustaining fees must be postmarked on or before the due date. No exceptions, No refunds. Any one submitting a check not honored by its bank will have their entry dropped from the futurity. If they wish to re-enter, they will be subject to late penalties plus all fees due. TRIALS: Should there be a malfunction of the electric timer during any trials, qualifiers shall be determined by the order of finish. No allowances will be made due to a change in track or weather conditions during the running of the trials. Should one of more horses in separate trials receive the same time, the qualifiers shall be determined by shaking of number pills. Should one horse in the same trial receive the same time, the order of finish shall determine the qualifier. If ten or less horses remain eligible at the time of entry for trials, no trials shall be held. The futurity will have ten qualifiers. If a horse scratches, it will receive last place money. If two or more horses scratch, they will divide equally the purse money for their respective places. Any horse that qualifies for the finals but is unable to participate in the finals (excluding a bad test), will receive last place money without having to enter. The trainer must notify the racing office at time of entry, then last place money will be awarded when purses are paid. There will be no also eligible list, with the exception of a bad test or owner suspension. The next non-qualifier will be allowed in the finals. In all cases, the decision of the stewards is final. All horses must be tattooed before entry. All two years olds must be approved to start by the starter and/or stewards.

The "ARIZONA TRIPLE CROWN" is a series of three races to be run each year on the County Fairs and at Turf Paradise and Yavapai Downs.

Points are given to each finalist (after trials) in the three races. Points are as follows:

First Place –	10
Second Place -	9
Third Place -	8
Fourth Place -	7
Fifth Place -	6
Sixth Place -	5
Seventh Place -	4
Eighth Place -	3
Ninth Place -	2
Tenth Place -	1

The first leg of the Arizona Triple Crown is the "Desert Classic Futurity". Trials for the 2005 Season will be April 9, at the Graham County Race Track in Safford, Arizona. The finals will be run Friday April 29, at Turf Paradise in Phoenix, Arizona. Eligibility for this race is any two-year-old that is by a stallion whose service was sold through the AQRA Stallion Service Auction for it's breeding season. The list of stallions will be on the Futurity Blank.

The second leg of the Arizona Triple Crown is the "ASOA Futurity" Trials for the 2005 season will be July 9, and finals will run July 30 at Yavapai Downs in Prescott Valley. Eligibility to run in this race is any two-year-old must be by a stallion that stands exclusively in Arizona.

The third leg of the Arizona Triple Crown is the "AQRA Stallion Futurity". Trials and Finals for this leg will be run in the fall of 2005 at Turf Paradise. The dates are not set as yet. Eligibility to run in this race is for any two-year-old by a nominated stallion who stands in Arizona. A List of the Eligible Stallions is on the Futurity Blank.
