

## Reprint Policy of APHA Copyrighted Material

*Information for Publishers and Webmasters wanting to reprint copyrighted stories and photographs produced by the Paint Horse Journal, Paint Horse Racing and Paint Horse Connection.*

If you wish to reprint any article or photograph (does not apply to press releases) from [apha.com](http://www.apha.com) or its affiliated sites on your website, forum, blog or digital publication, please ensure to follow our reprint policy:

- Respect the copyright of the author and APHA by including the full headline of the story and the byline of the author as well as the publication.
- Only run the introduction paragraph of the story, in its entirety with no changes to the content. No other part of the story can be reprinted.
- Provide a link back to the article on APHA's website for readers to read the remainder of the story. (For example: Read the rest of the story by Jessica Hein of the Paint Horse Journal by clicking [here](#).)
- Include the following paragraph at the end of every reprinted story:
  - **More about APHA:** The American Paint Horse Association (<http://www.apha.com>), founded in 1962 and headquartered in Fort Worth, Texas, is the international breed registry for the American Paint Horse. In fulfillment of its mission to collect, record and preserve pedigrees of the breed, APHA recognizes and supports 111 regional and international clubs, produces championship shows, sponsors trail rides and creates and maintains programs that increase the value of American Paint Horses and enriches members' experiences with their horses. APHA has registered almost a million horses in 59 nations and territories since it was founded, and now serves approximately 64,000 active members around the world.
- You can include the story's accompanying photograph as long as the watermark remains on the photo. It cannot be cropped out and the photo cannot be altered in anyway.
- When including the photo, you must include the photographer's byline and the publication.

- APHA reserves the right to deny the reprinting of APHA copyrighted material on websites deemed inappropriate by APHA management. Webmasters and Publishers who violate APHA's reprint policy will also be denied reprint rights.
